STANDARDS FOR COMMUNICATIONS AND POSTERS

The work must be unpublished and presented with scientific rigor. They will be reviewed by at least two evaluators and accepted by the scientific committee. All accepted papers will be published with ISBN. They can be written in English only.

PAPERS/ PROCEEDINGS :

The whole length shall not exceed of 10 pages A-4 written in 1.5 line spacing, where tables, figures, pictures and references are included. The authors must follow guide for authors strictly (use manuscript template or refer to Procedia-ESEM guidelines at <http://www.procedia-esem.eu/instructions.htm>), failing which the manuscripts would be rejected without review. Editors reserve the right to adjust the style to certain standards of uniformity.

Manuscripts should be concise, in 1.5 line spacing, and should have 2 cm all over margins. The font should be Times New Roman of size 12 points. The numbering of chapters should be in decimal form. Ensure that each new paragraph is clearly indicated, using TAB at 1.25 pts.

The title page will contain:

A concise and informative title (Times New Roman bold, all caps of size 13 points); the maximum length of the title should be 150 letters and spaces; The full name(s) of the author(s) (first name, then last name, with Times New Roman bold 11 points) should be written below the title. The affiliation(s) and complete postal address (es) of the author(s) will be provided immediately after the full name of the authors and will be written with Times New Roman italic 9 points. When the paper has more than one author, their name will be followed by a mark (Arabic numeral) as superscript; for the corresponding author, two asterisks will be added using Word_Insert_Reference_Footnote_Symbol sequence. Also, the full and e-mail addresses, telephone and fax numbers of the corresponding author will be provided in the footer of the first page, as: Corresponding author: email..., Only one corresponding author has to be provided.


Abstract

Each manuscript must be preceded by an abstract presenting the most important results and conclusions in no more than 300 words, written with Times New Roman 9 points.

Keywords

Three to five keywords should be supplied after the Abstract for indexing purposes, ordered alphabetically, using American spelling and avoiding general and plural terms and multiple concepts (avoid, for example, "and", "of"). Be sparing with abbreviations: only abbreviations firmly established in the field may be eligible. These keywords will be used for indexing purposes.

The text of the paper should be divided into Introduction, Experimental, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, References (or Case-studies presentation instead of Experimental).

The text layout must be on a single column.

Introduction

State the objectives of the work and provide an adequate background, avoiding a detailed literature survey or a summary of the results.

Material and methods

Provide sufficient detail to allow the work to be reproduced. Methods already published should be indicated by a reference: only relevant modifications should be described.

Results and Discussion

Results should be clear and concise. Discussion should explore the significance of the results of the work, not repeat them. Avoid extensive citations and discussion of published literature.

Conclusions

The main conclusions drawn from results should be presented in a short Conclusions section (maximum 100 words).

Formulae, symbols and abbreviations

Formulae will be typeset in Italics (preferable with the Equation Editor) and should be written or marked for such in the manuscript, unless they require a different styling. The formulae should be quoted on the right side, between brackets:

$$(x_1+x_2)^2 = x_1^2 + x_2^2 + 2x_1x_2 \quad (1)$$

Abbreviations should be defined when first mentioned in the abstract and again in the main body of the text and used consistently thereafter.

SI units must be used throughout.


Footnotes should be avoided.

Acknowledgements

Include acknowledgements in a separate section at the end of the article before the references and do not, therefore, include them on the title page, as a footnote to the title or otherwise. List here those individuals who provided help during the research (e.g., providing language help, writing assistance or proof reading the article, funding supports etc.).

Tables

Draw the tables in grid format using a basic, solid line style without shadows. Ensure that the data presented in Tables do not duplicate results described in Figures or elsewhere in the article.

Figures

Number Figures consecutively in accordance with their appearance in the text. All illustrations should be provided in camera-ready form, suitable for reproduction, which may include reduction without retouching.

Photographs, charts and diagrams are all to be referred to as Figure(s) and should be numbered consecutively, in the order to which they are referred.

Figures may be inserted as black line drawings. They should be pasted on, rather than taped, since the latter results in unclear edges upon reproduction.

Ensure that each illustration has a caption, placed below the Figure. A caption should comprise a brief title (not on the Figure itself) and a description of the illustration. Keep text in the illustrations themselves to a minimum but explain all symbols and abbreviations used. Multiple Figures can be expressed as one Figure (for e.g. 1a, 1b, 1c etc...), while retaining the maximum limit of 6.

ALL Figures must be submitted in either .jpg or .tiff format with a very good resolution (but do not submit graphics that are disproportionately large for the content).

Figures and Tables must be embedded in the text.

References

They will be inserted in the text with the author's surname and the year (Brierley and Fryirs, 2005), and if more than two authors as: (Tockner et al., 2002). All references cited be reflected in the final list, which shall be expressed as the following examples:



Poster A1-Poster A1 and pdf including, title, authors, and thematic area For posters can present r a document not exceeding 5 pages, A4 written in single line spacing, where tables , figures , pictures and references are included.

FORMAT AND TEXT FEATURES

The margins on each page will be 2.5 cm on all four sides. The title of the paper or poster will be in capital letters, bold, centered and **TIMES NEW ROMAN 13** `

The name and surname of the author will be placed below the title, in small letters, bold, centered and Times New Roman 11 point.

The names of organizations or workplaces will be written under the authors, in small letters and italics, centered and *time New roman 9 Kursive* points, identified by asterisks which corresponds to each author. The corresponding author will add the email address

It should include keywords in number not exceeding five words

In each communication or poster a person should make as correspondent with the organization. In case of several authors, the correspondent will be identified underlining its name. and with the e-mail

Before the text contained a summary of no more than 200 words in Times new roman 9 point will be included.

All text should be written Times New Roman 10 -point t. Color black (auto) and justified alignment.

There will be no footnotes page.

A space between paragraphs should be left blank.

There shall be no indentation beginning of paragraph

SENDING AND PUBLICATION DEADLINES FOR COMMUNICATION

At least one author of each paper or poster must be registered in the the conference, **before the August** first and its compulsory attendance to present the communication and the posters. The deadline to send the article is **August 15 th**

All accepted papers as oral presentation will be published in Procedia Environmental Science, Engineering and Management (ISSN: 2392 – 9537).
